

WEB APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

This application packet contains: 1) an Application for Admission; 2) a Statement of Faith; 3) one pastor's Reference Form; 4) one Teach Reference Form; 5) an Essay & Declaration Form.

To be considered for admission, you must have been a Christian for at least one year. In addition, you must also submit the following items for consideration:

1. Application for Admission

A. Complete and sign the application. In so doing, you agree with the Statement of Faith of the Greek Bible College (GrBC), and your willingness to adhere to our social, educational, and devotional standards. These standards are summarized in the current Student Handbook. Please make sure that you are aware of our Mission Statement before signing the application.

B. Enclose the application fee of 35 Euros or \$50 (USA). Make check or money order payable to the Greek Bible College. Please include your name on your check or money order. Do not send cash. This fee is not refundable.

2. Statement of Faith

Read and sign the Statement of Faith form. If you are not in agreement or are unsure of any item in this statement, please note that exception and sign the form with your noted exception that you are either in disagreement or unsure about that item.

3. Essay & Declaration

It is our aim to get to know you as well as possible through this part of the application process. This is an opportunity for further self-expression in responding to the questions candidly. Please answer the questions sufficiently so the Admissions Committee can make a fair evaluation. Your essay should be clear, concise, and complete. Sign the Declaration on the form. Please type all information.

4. References

Complete the top part of each form. Please make sure to write your name on the forms before distributing them. Referents should return their letter directly to the Registrar – Alpha Program.

A. Pastor's reference: If your church is without a pastor, or if the pastor is a relative, this form may be given to a former pastor, a minister friend, or a church elder. It must be someone who has known you for at least one year and has had the opportunity to observe your spiritual life. The individual cannot be a relative.

B. Teacher's reference: Complete the top part of the form; give it to your high school teacher. This form should be completed if you are currently in high school. Reference form should be returned in a sealed envelope directly to the Registrar – Alpha Program.

5. ACT/SAT

Applicants are required to take one of these tests no later than the early part of their senior year, so that the results can be sent to the Admissions Office by the application deadline. Consult with your high school guidance counselor for testing information. Exemption is granted only to those who have completed one year (30 semester hours) of college level work with a minimum of 2.5 GPA.

6. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)

This test must be taken by all international applicants from countries where English is not the official language. A minimum score of 61 (IBT– Internet Based Test) or 500 (PBT–Paper Based Test) is required for admission. To take the test you should apply directly to TOEFL, Educational Testing Service, P.O. Because the examination is given only a few times each year, it is important to write at the earliest possible date. Information about taking the examination is provided by the testing service. Results are to be sent directly to the Greek Bible College. International students are expected to possess sufficient proficiency to engage in full-time study in the English language. An International student application will not be considered until the results of this exam are received.

7. Transcripts

Request official transcripts from all schools attended to be sent directly to the Registrar of the Alpha Program at GrBC. All transcripts are required. Transfer candidates must submit both high school and college transcripts, and international students must have all documents and records translated into English.

8. Home School Students

The GrBC recognizes home schooling as a viable educational alternative and welcomes applications from qualified home schooled students. Please submit an official transcript or a GED plus student's ACT or SAT score for evaluation.
